

#### **COACH TRAINING SEMINAR**

What:

This seminar is part of the USA Archery High Performance Program and is the second in a series of coach training seminars designed and presented by National Head Coach, Kisik Lee, in an effort to train coaches around the country. The training will focus on the BEST Shot Technique (Coach Lee's system), Sports Science for archery and effective coaching methods.

Why:

1) To train USA Archery Coaches in Coach Lee's system.
2) From this and future seminars, Coach Lee, hopes to identify a set of Regional High Performance Coaches.
